<u>Hike Details</u>: Terrain is moderate with a few short steep sections. Mostly in the woods, some in the field. Duration is about an hour and a half to two hours, but you can leave early if you like. Hike will be limited to 20 participants. Sign up at the link above.

<u>What to Bring</u>: Water, snack, hat, sunscreen, mosquito repellent, trekking poles if desired. Wear sturdy, closed-toed shoes for hiking and dress for the weather. Heavy rains or high winds will cancel.
